

AN ORDINANCE # 210

PROHIBITING THE BURNING OF BRUSH AND TRASH WITH IN THE CITY AND PRESCRIBING
PENALTY OF A FINE OF NOT LESS THAN \$1.00 NOR MORE THAN \$200.00.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRAKETTville, TEXAS:

Section 1. Trash Burning Prohibited: It shall be unlawful to burn brush, tree limbs, grass, tree leaves, boards, planks, or lumber in the city limits.

Section 2. Penalty: Any person convicted of violating this ordinance shall be punished by fine of not less than \$1.00 nor more than \$200.00.

Section 3. Effective Date: This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.

PASSED AND APPROVED 9TH DAY OF MARCH 1981

AMENDED ORDINANCE # 210

AMMENDMENT – To prohibit burning of household garbage of any kind within the City limits to include in addition to Sections (1), (2), (3);

(4) Kitchen garbage, untreated lumber, cardboard boxes, clothing;

(5) Tires, construction debris, furniture, carpet, electrical wiring, appliances.

Exception 30 TAC § 111.207 subject to the requirements § 111.219(7).

EFFECTIVE DATE- This ordinance as amended shall become effective immediately upon it's passage, approval and publication as provide by law.

It is my understanding the procedure that has been established throughout the year's, is that a citizen calls and notifies the dispatcher of the proposed control burn. And that time (he/she) is given a yes or no on whether it is permissible.

I'm requesting your assistance on this matter. If at all possible could we have the dispatcher confirm that the proposed burn is outside of the city limits? If it is within the city limits advise the person making the request, of the current ordinance prohibiting burning within the city.

BLOCKING OF STREETS BY CITY

An ordinance whereas during periods of construction or repairs the City maintenance crew find it necessary at time to blockade streets and alleys to protect the public from injury and property damage. Therefore it shall be unlawful for anyone not connected with the City or upon instructions from proper City Officials to remove, change or alter in any way any barricade, flare or sign of any kind placed by the City of Brackettville or their representatives.

Prohibiting the burning of brush and trash within the city and prescribing a penalty of a fine of not less than \$1.00 nor more than \$200.00.

Passed and approved on Regular Meeting on March 9, 1981. Mayor Chris Gomez read to the Council ordinance #210, burning ordinance. Motion was made by Alderman Lingo Sandoval and 2nd by Alderman Robert Garza to approve burning ordinance #210 deleting burning of trash (Household garbage) or that household garbage burning will be permitted. This ordinance supercedes all other burning ordinances. The effective date for this ordinance is March 9, 1981. ALL AYES.
