

**CITY OF BRACKETTVILLE
RESOLUTION NO. 2026-14 -04_MP**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BRACKETTVILLE, TEXAS, RATIFYING CERTAIN PREVIOUSLY APPROVED POLICIES, INCLUDING THE CITIZEN PARTICIPATION PLAN AND GRIEVANCE POLICY, EXCESSIVE FORCE POLICY, FAIR HOUSING POLICY, SECTION 504 POLICY, GRIEVANCE PROCEDURES, AND CODE OF CONDUCT POLICY; CONFIRMING SUCH POLICIES REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT; AUTHORIZING IMPLEMENTATION; FINDING THAT THE MEETING AT WHICH THIS RESOLUTION IS PASSED IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AS REQUIRED BY LAW; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Brackettville ("the City") is a general law municipality operating under the laws of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, the City is committed to promoting the health, safety, and general welfare of its residents; and

WHEREAS, the City has previously adopted and implemented various policies in connection with its operations, including policies required for participation in certain state and federal programs; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to formally ratify and reaffirm certain policies to ensure clarity, consistency, and compliance with applicable legal and program requirements; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that ratification of these policies serves the public interest and promotes transparency, accountability, and effective governance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRACKETTVILLE, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. RATIFICATION OF POLICIES

The City Council hereby ratifies, confirms, and approves the following policies, which were previously adopted and/or implemented by the City:

1. **Citizen Participation Plan and Grievance Policy;**
2. **Excessive Force Policy;**
3. **Fair Housing Policy;**
4. **Section 504 Policy;**
5. **Grievance Procedures;** and
6. **Code of Conduct Policy.**

SECTION 2. INCORPORATION BY REFERENCE

The policies identified in Section 1, including any prior amendments thereto, are hereby incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein. Copies of such policies may be maintained in the official records of the City and, where applicable, attached hereto as **Exhibit "A."**

SECTION 3. CONTINUING VALIDITY

The policies ratified by this Resolution are confirmed to remain in full force and effect unless and until amended, superseded, or repealed by the City Council.

SECTION 4. NO SUBSTANTIVE AMENDMENT

This Resolution is intended solely to ratify and reaffirm existing policies and does not create new policies or materially modify the substance of the policies identified herein.

SECTION 5. AUTHORIZATION AND IMPLEMENTATION

The City Administrator, Department Heads, and all appropriate City officials are hereby authorized and directed to implement, administer, and enforce the policies ratified by this Resolution and to take all actions reasonably necessary to ensure compliance with applicable laws and program requirements.

SECTION 6. RATIFICATION OF PRIOR ACTIONS

All prior actions taken by the City, its officers, employees, and agents consistent with the policies ratified herein are hereby ratified, approved, and confirmed in all respects.

SECTION 7. OPEN MEETING

It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Resolution is passed is open to the public as required by law and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required.

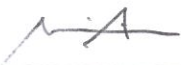
SECTION 8. SEVERABILITY
