WHEREAS, the right to fair housing is recognized as a fundamental component of a just and equitable society; and

WHEREAS, the Fair Housing Act, enacted as Title VIII of the Civil Rights Act of 1968, prohibits discrimination in the sale, rental, and financing of housing based on race, color, religion, sex, disability, familial status, or national origin; and

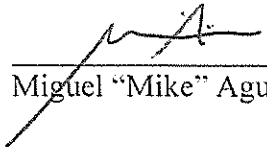
WHEREAS, April marks the anniversary of the passage of the Fair Housing Act and serves as a time to recognize the importance of eliminating housing discrimination and promoting equal housing opportunities for all persons; and

WHEREAS, the City of Brackettville is committed to supporting fair housing practices, encouraging inclusive communities, and ensuring that all residents have access to safe, decent, and affordable housing free from discrimination; and

WHEREAS, the City encourages residents, property owners, landlords, real estate professionals, lenders, and community organizations to become aware of their rights and responsibilities under fair housing laws and to work together to eliminate housing discrimination; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Miguel "Mike" Aguirre, Mayor of the City of Brackettville, and the members of the Brackettville City Council do hereby proclaim April as "**FAIR HOUSING MONTH**" and encourage all residents to observe this month by reaffirming their commitment to fair housing principles and equal opportunity for all.

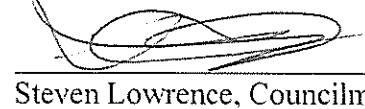

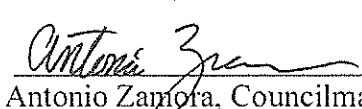
